Dear Parent/Carer,

As we move in to our final week at Greenacre Academy it is important that we detail how the last week at school for your son/ward this academic year will look.

Monday 18th July lessons will take place as normal, therefore your son should arrive at normal time – 8.30am, in full uniform, without his blazer due to the weather. Lessons 1-6 will take place as normal. It is important that your son brings his school bag with him on this day as he may wish to bring his school books for this Academic year home with him, any library books that he has borrowed should also be returned on this date.

Tuesday 19th July all students can attend school in sportswear/PE kit. This is due to the activities we have planned for your son/ward. If your son is due to attend a school trip that meets at the venue, he is not expected to attend school until the meet time at the venue. A register will be taken at the meet time and place and you will be notified if your son has not arrived. If your son is not due to be on a trip on Tuesday he should attend school as normal where we have off timetable lessons and activities planned for him, these will be enrichment activities so he is not required to bring his bag, book or stationery for the day.

Wednesday 20th July all students are welcome to attend in sportswear/PE kit. If your son is on the Chessington/Thorpe Park/laser games trip you will have received notification of a meet time and venue for this trip. . If your son is not due to be on a trip on Wednesday he should attend school as normal where we have off timetable lessons and activities planned for him, these will be enrichment activities so he is not required to bring his bag, book or stationery for the day.

Thursday 21st July all students may wear their own clothes. Your son/ward will attend their timetable period 1&2 lessons where they will take part in some fun activities. Following this there will be reward assemblies and form time. Students will finish school at 1.15pm. If your son/ward is entitled to a free school meal, he will be able to receive this at break time on Thursday.

All students will be dismissed at 1.15pm, were school will close for the summer.

We look forward to seeing your son/ward until the very last day, it is important to us that your son enjoys the community feel that we have created and spends time celebrating getting through our first 'post-covid' year.

The weather looks to remain warm, so please ensure your son has a supply of water and wears sun lotion when he is due to be outside.
