These subjects remain compulsory for options and so an insight/feedback on progress will be invaluable. Rather than organising a Parents Evening and an Options Evening, we will encapsulate this in one and include showcasing all of the options available to your child.

There will be a presentation regarding the options process, then options booklets will be provided at this event and a deadline will be shared with you for the return. Student option choices will be expected to be sent electronically, so it is beneficial if you can attend the Headteacher talk to gather this information.


