SCHEME OF WORK: BADMINTON: YEAR 6

LESSON	OUTLINE OF LESSON
1	Students learn the correct terminology for the court markings on a Badminton court and develop the forehand drive shot.
2	Students take part in a number of exercises which helps them to learn how to perform the backhand drive in Badminton.
3	Students understand what is a net shot and how it can be used to outwit an opponent in a competitive game of Badminton.
4	Pupils learn how to perform a short and a deep serve and why these serves are used in Badminton.
5	Students learn how to play a winning shot in a competitive game of badminton – Smash.
6	Students continue to develop their ability to play a competitive game of badminton and also learn how to umpire a game of singles and doubles using the correct court markings.
