We continue our procedures surrounding the use of the one way system and our ban on mobile phones. I would like to thank all of our students for their observance of the one way system as it has really embeded at school, and we have seen a distinct improvement in the conduct of students around the school site. The same can be said for mobile phones. As always there have been some teething issues putting this in place, however on the whole students have observed the ban and we have been able to hold wonderful conversations and deal with incidents before the inevitable social media spread of gossip and rumour. As a result the school has become a quieter and more productive place of work.
