Re: Year 11 Mock Exams: 21st November to 1st December 2023

I'm writing to give you the Year 11 Mock Exam timetable for next term. These exams play a pivotal role in preparing the students for the real GCSEs and are vital in helping us provide the support and necessary guidance for their success.

- Assessment of Progress:** The mock exams provide us with an opportunity to gauge your child's academic progress/attainment and report it back, accurately, to you at the end of Term 2.
- Identifying Areas of Intervention:** By analysing the mock exam results, we can identify specific areas where students may need additional help or intervention. We will reform the 'Form Focus' Intervention groups accordingly.
- Reducing Exam Anxiety:** Taking mock exams familiarises students with the examination process, helping to reduce anxiety and build confidence ahead of the real GCSEs. It's a chance for them to practice time management, any access arrangements, and test-taking skills.

Half-Term Revision

We are including a timetable of Mock Exam Revision Sessions taking place over the Half-Term break. These sessions are optional, but we very much urge your children to attend if they can.

Revision Materials

Students were provided with a printed GCSE Revision Pack at the Information Evening. But staff have also been working on Mock Exam Knowledge Organisers, specifically made with these mocks in mind.
