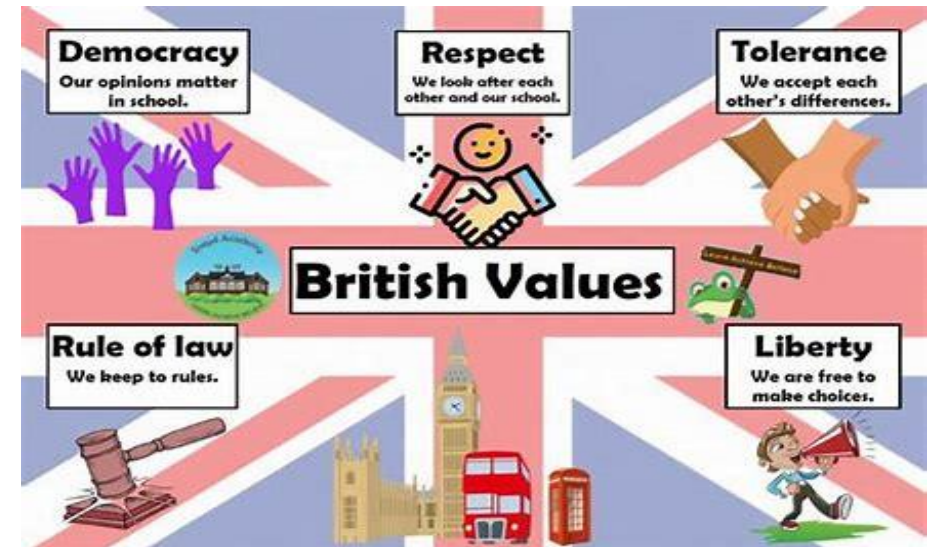
Extended writing

Could you go out into the community and offer your qualities and help?



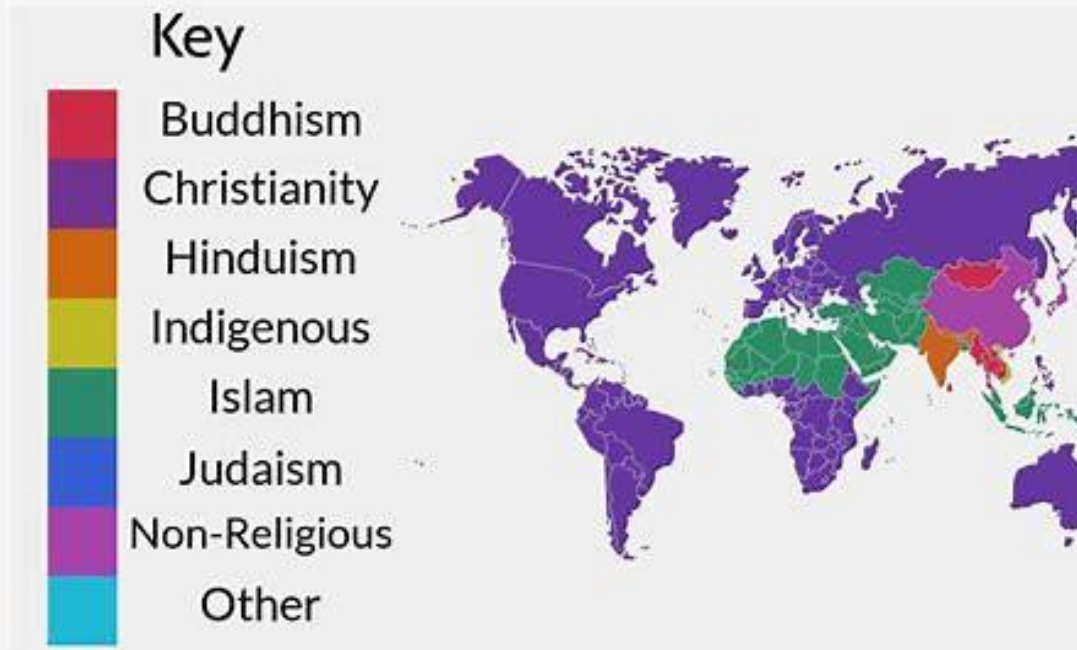
The wider community

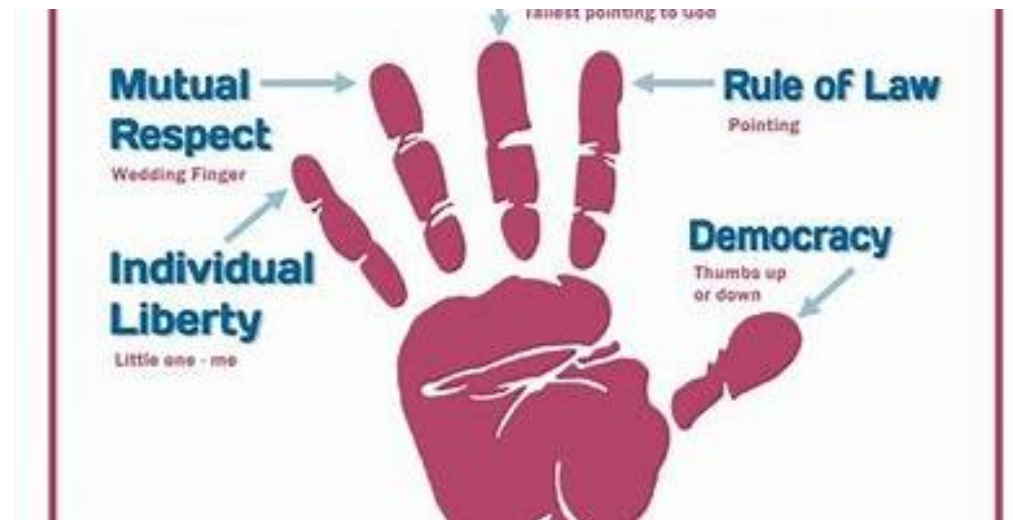
Religions and Communities
