## 100-day Challenge

With the first of the GCSE exams approaching on the 12th of May 2025, we are pleased to introduce the '100 Day Challenge', commencing on Friday, 31st January 2025.

The 100 Day Challenge is a huge programme of extra revision and intervention sessions, encompassing nearly 700 learning opportunities. The challenge follows the 100 days leading up to the first GCSE exam. We offer a revision or intervention opportunity for every single one of those 100 days, even the weekends. These sessions, varying in focus from academic revision to general study skills and wellbeing, are thoughtfully planned to cater to every learner's style and give them an opportunity to develop their GCSE skills and earn rewards whilst they do so.

For every session attended or task completed, students will earn a '100 Day Credit', through our values point system. These credits accumulate to earn rewards, ranging from a free cookie to a trip to Thorpe Park (ticket purchase required). There will be additional credits for students maintaining 100% attendance throughout these 100 days.

To keep you informed and involved, we will attach the **100 Day Challenge Calendar** with this email. More detailed information about each event, and regular reminders, will be provided by our dedicated staff prior to each session. Please note we have not included half term or Easter holidays in this calendar, as intervention over these weeks is still being organised, details coming to you soon.

We understand the importance of parental support in this journey. Your encouragement in ensuring your child/ward's attendance and engagement in these sessions is invaluable.

Please be advised, also, that the final round of Mock Exams will be taking place from 24th February 2025. I will be in touch again nearer the time with information and key dates for you.
